

Pray for Hungary

Budapest

BU-da-pesht s the capital of Hungary with the third largest parliament building in the world and the second largest synagogue in the world. It has more thermal water springs than any other capital city in the world making it the “Capital of spas” since 1937

Lord, we ask that you would swing wide open the gates of this capital city in order that You, the King of glory, may come in (Psalm 24). Population: 1,741,041

Debrecen

DE-bre-tsen, the second largest city, is referred to as the “Calvinist Rome” (with the biggest Reformed church in Hungary: floor area is 1500 square meters.)

The Reformed College of Debrecen, operates here since 1538. *Lord, we ask that the people from Debrecen will come to know you and let you reform their hearts so they will be like living stones, being built into a spiritual house, to be a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to You God through Jesus Christ. (1Peter 2:5)* Population: 202,520

Szeged

SE-ged may come from an old Hungarian word for corner ('szeg'), pointing to the turn of the River Tisza that flows through the city. It is the third largest city and also known as the "City of Sunshine" because it has the most sunny days each year.

Father we pray that the people in Szeged will recognize Jesus as the Cornerstone and those walking in darkness in this city would see Your great Light—Let Your Light dawn over their deepest places of darkness (Isaiah 9:2 ; 28:16).

Population: 161,879

Miskolc

Mish-koltz, known for its heavy industry, is surrounded by the beautiful Bukk mountains with a unique thermal cave bath.

Father, bring people in Miskolc to see that You alone are the Rock. Train their hands to do impossible things for Your glory, sustained by Your strength (Psalm 18:30-36).

Population: 157,639

Pecs

Pech is an ancient city founded by Romans, close to the Croatian border. Pecs prospered as a multicultural epicenter, the peaceful union of Hungarians, Croatians, Serbians, Germans, and other ethnic groups garnering it the nickname of “the Borderless City.” *Lord, we ask that all these nations who live in Pecs will come to know the Prince of Peace and the reconciliation He offers (Ephesians 2:14-17)*

Population: 156,049

Győr

Gyur is an important cultural center, a famous university town, and a popular tourist destination. It is a hub for rail and road traffic.

Lord, we pray that the people of Gyor would find the road that leads to Life, and joyfully leave all else behind (Matthew 7:13-14)

Population: 129,527

Nyiregyhaza

NEE-reg-há-za is an important market centre for agricultural products, especially apples. Nyiregyhaza is known for its zoo, which exhibits more than 500 species including a number of rarities.

Lord, we pray that the people in Nyireghaza would come to Jesus and they would find the abundant life You offer (John 10:10)

Population: 117,874

Kecskemet & Szekesfehervar

KECH-ke-met is referred as the “orchard of Hungary” providing a much of the country’s apricots *SE-kesh-fe-her-var* was the capital of the Kingdom of Hungary in the middle ages, 43 kings were crowned here and 15 were buried here between 1000-1540.

Population: 111,269 & 100,570

Lord we ask that Your kingdom and your rule come in the lives of the people from these cities (Matthew 6:10)
